**Under this agreement for 2017
Labrador State School will receive**

\$582,395*

This funding will be used to:

- Increase Year 3 NAPLAN Upper Two Bands (Reading) from 54% to 55%
- Increase Year 3 NAPLAN Upper Two Bands (Numeracy) from 23% to 30%
- Increase Year 5 NAPLAN Upper Two Bands (Reading) from 32% to 50%
- Increase Year 5 NAPLAN Upper Two Bands (Numeracy) from 24% to 25%

Our initiatives include:

- Employment of two Heads of Curriculum to co plan and co teach with staff building teacher knowledge and skills capacity using the Australian Curriculum
- Employing a support teacher English as Additional Language or Dialect (EAL/D) to support teachers and students across P-6
- Employing a teacher in the Intensive English Centre to support refugee students in their first year of English schooling

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Employing 2 x Heads of Curriculum (Reading/ Numeracy)	\$ 262,000
Employing 1 x teacher for English as an additional language or dialect	\$ 94,000
Employing 0.7 FTE teacher the Intensive English Class	\$ 66,000
Employing 1x teacher for differentiation	\$ 94,000
TA Levelled Literacy Intervention	\$ 14,000
TA Get Real	\$ 52,395
